The 32nd FISITA World Automotive Congress, which takes place in Munich, Germany from 14-19 September 2008, includes special programmes for students and young engineers.

The **Student Congress** runs in parallel to the main congress and gives engineering students the opportunity to meet in a technical forum with their peer group from other countries world wide.

They are invited to present their own paper at the Student Congress and also get the opportunity to attend sessions of the main international World Automotive congress. The topics of the Student Congress are the same as for the main FISITA 2008 World Automotive Congress:

The aim of the **Travelling Fellowship Programme** is to encourage the professional development of outstanding young engineers by facilitating their attendance at the FISITA 2008 World Automotive Congress and providing an opportunity for interaction with peer engineers from different countries all over the world.

The programme starts one week before the main congress with a variety of technical tours to famous automotive sites of Germany (e.g. BMW, Daimler, MAN, Technical University of Munich and many more).
